CDH-Vergas fire department had their budget meeting earlier in the evening and Dora's percentage of support will increase from 20.6% to 21.1% increasing to \$22,286.38 for the year, to be paid in quarterly amounts.

Also Dent fire department is estimating that they will need a 3% increase to \$12,800.00, though it is only an estimate at this time.
