Meeting was called to order by Joe Gerold, at 7:00 pm.

The minutes for the September meeting were read. David Antonsen moved to approve the minutes, Daryl Haarstick seconded motion, motion passed.

Treasurer's report was read and placed on file subject to audit.

David Antonsen reported on the CDH/Vergas Fire and Rescue Budget report, the joint council approved a budget increase of 3%. Candor's portion of the budget is 23%, Dora's portion is 22%, Hobart's portion is 46% and the City of Vergas' portion is 11%. The annual meeting is set for February 1, 2022. David Antonsen moved to approve the 3% increase for the CDH/Vergas Fire and Rescue budget. Daryl Haarstick seconded the motion, motion passed.

There is a dead tree in the right of way on Wildwood Dr., the tree removal will require a lift truck due to other obstacles in the vicinity.

Joe Gerold met with the Edna town board concerning the muskrat problem on Engstrom Beach Road, Edna approved hiring Kurt Osterfelt to work on the problem by digging a trench and putting metal plates in the ground to stop the muskrats from tunneling under the road. Daryl Haarstick moved to do as the mutual boards recommend. David Antonsen seconded the motion, motion passed.

Daryl reported on a pile of gravel on Summerset Road, if the party that placed it there doesn't move it in the next couple of weeks, permission was given to have Bryan Soland move it off the road right of way.
