Dora township board met for the monthly meeting @ 29375 430<sup>th</sup> St. Vergas, Mn.

Meeting was called to order by David Antonsen, at 7:00 pm.

The minutes for the February meeting were read. Joe Gerold moved to approve the minutes, Daryl Haarstick seconded the motion, motion passed.

Treasurer's report was read and placed on file subject to audit.

Joe Gerold and Hans Hanson helped with the CDH/Vergas Audit, everything checked out.

Joe Gerold moved to switch website managers to Big Groovy, Daryl Haarstick seconded the motion, motion passed. Mike will work with both managers to transition to new manager.

The bike trail was discussed, as the county is proceeding in the Great River Energy power line easement, located beside the south side of 440<sup>th</sup> Street between County roads 35 and 41. Mike received an email from the engineering firm explaining the two areas that will be in the road right of way. They are going to try to attend our next meeting on April 1<sup>st</sup>.

S@N Sealcoating and Cracksealing sent an estimate of \$11,150.00 for sealing cracks on our asphalt roads. Daryl Haarstick moved to hire them for the year 2021 to do the cracksealing on our roads. Joe Gerold seconded the motion, motion passed. (Note, if any cracks need sealing on 410<sup>th</sup> Street that is not included on the estimate.)

Hill and Valley Road will be cracksealed and the board will look into whether there needs to be more extensive repairs.

Weed meeting is at 10:00 AM on March 18<sup>th</sup>, in Perham.

Daryl Haarstick moved to accept the bid from Soland Rock and Gravel for blading and snow removal for the year 2021-2022.

Blading at \$125.00/hr,

Snow plowing at \$125.00/hr,

Pickup snow plowing at \$95.00/hr,

No snow plow \$2,000.00

With diesel fuel clause: Base price of #2 Fuel \$2.65 gallon

Winter fuel base price of \$2.70 gallon.

If fuel increase goes up 5 cents per gallon of base price add \$2.00 per hour of machines.

Joe Gerold seconded motion, motion passed.
