Dora township board met for the monthly meeting @ 29375 430th St. Vergas, Mn.

Meeting was called to order by Joe Gerold, at 7:00 pm.

Pledge of Allegiance was said.

The minutes for the March meeting were read. Daryl Haarstick moved to approve the minutes, David Antonsen seconded the motion, motion passed.

Treasurer's report was read and placed on file subject to audit.

Mike Kratzke shared about talking with Attorney Charlie Ramstad. He recommended that an agreement be signed between the county and the township describing liability and upkeep of the trail running through Dora Township. Mike will contact him and see if he would be available to come to our May 6th meeting, as we hope to have representatives from both the county and the engineering firm.

Several residents of 440th Street were in attendance to discuss having a speed limit being installed on the stretch of 440th between 300th Ave and East Spirit Drive. David Antonsen talked with Oliver Kendall and he said that part of that meets the criteria for a 35 MPH speed limit. There was also discussion about adding a Blind Child sign. David will talk to Oliver and see what can legally be done.

David Antonsen moved to leave election judge pay at its current level of \$15.00/hour plus mileage. Daryl seconded the motion, motion passed.

There are 2 Chevron signs down on 440th St. Oliver Kendall is aware of these and they will be placed back up.

Daryl Haarstick moved to give donations to these places this year. AmVets \$300.00, East Otter Tail County History Museum \$300.00, Perham Center for the Arts \$300.00, East Otter Tail County Fair \$300.00, Perham Public Library \$300.00, Pelican Rapids Public Library \$300.00, Neighbor to Neighbor \$300.00, Otter Tail County Historical Society \$300.00. David Antonsen seconded motion, motion passed.

Daryl Haarstick moved to donate \$5,000 for a bench for the Veteran's Memorial Park in Vergas. David Antonsen seconded the motion, motion passed.

Daryl Haarstick moved to not put a speed zone on Sybil Lake Road, David Antonsen seconded the motion, motion passed.

David Antonsen moved to accept the quote from Stenger Dust Control for dust guarding selected gravel roads. Daryl Haarstick seconded the motion, motion passed. Decisions for the application will be finalized on the road tour.

Road tour is set for April 8th, 2021 starting at 9:00 am from David Antonsen's place.

David Antonsen moved to accept the gravel bid from Northwest Pipe and Tank, Daryl Haarstick seconded the motion, motion passed. Bid is for Class 5 gravel with extra binder, at a price of \$9.25/yard.

Mark Stenger will be removing some rocks from 415th Street, he will be working with Bryan Soland to fill in and grade afterwards.

Hill and Valley Road will be looked at during the road tour to see what should be done.

Daryl Haarstick moved that David Antonsen be paid \$50 per meeting that has been held at his shop, since May 2020, 13 meetings for \$650. Joe Gerold seconded motion, motion passed 2 – 1.
