Dora township board met for the monthly meeting @ the CDH/Vergas Fire Hall meeting room Vergas, Mn.  
Meeting was called to order by Joe Gerold, at 7:00 pm.  
Pledge of Allegiance was said.

The minutes for February meeting were read. Daryl Haarstick moved to accept the minutes, David Helgerson seconded motion, motion passed.

The Treasurer's report was read and placed on file subject to audit.

David shared about CDH-Vergas Fire and Rescue, there will be a 10% increase to Dora's share of the budget. They are also looking at purchasing a used truck for \$200,000. Funding is planned for this vehicle.

David also shared about Perham EMS funding, there were discussions on options and questions of correct numbers, David is going to check in on the numbers used for the setting of the budget.

Daryl moved to Allow Arvig to install fiber optic cable in the road right of way with the condition that they install at the bottom of the slope and not on the shoulder of the road, also when crossing other township roads that they bore under the road and not cut across the road surface. David seconded the motion, motion passed.

Daryl moved to hire S@N Seal Coating and Crack Sealing to seal cracks for Dora township asphalt roads. David seconded motion, motion passed.

Daryl moved to accept the quote from Soland Rock and Gravel for blading and plowing snow for the year 2024-25. Blading rate \$130.00/hr., Snow plowing \$134 for Truck and Road Grader, \$95.00 pickup. No snow plow for months November thru March \$3000.00, kicks in under \$2,200.00. plus fuel differential for price increases. Joe seconded motion, motion passed.

Daryl moved to accept Corbin Excavating bid for dust guard. Doing the roads the same as last year. David seconded the motion, motion passed.

David moved to accept the Dent fire contract for 2024/2025 for service. \$13,850 per year, separated into 2 payments. Daryl seconded the motion, motion passed.
